Workshop on Management of RSETIs for Nodal Officers

Though there are different functionaries for monitoring of RSETIs, the major responsibility remains with the sponsoring Banks. At each Bank's corporate level, on the advice of NIRD, a senior officer is designated as Nodal Officer to monitor the performance of RSETIs and to guide them in their day to day affairs. With a view to equip Nodal Officers with the latest developments in the field of RSETIs and to build up their capacity, NIRD&PR is organizing a workshop every year. For the year 2014, three days workshop was conducted from 8th-10th September.

The objectives of the workshop was to review present status of the RSETIs, to review progress in allotment of the land, progress in construction of RSETI's buildings, to improve the functioning of RSETIs, monitoring of RSETIs, to improve bank linkages of trainees and to have cross learning by sharing best practices adopted by various banks/ RSETIs. The total number of participants for the workshop were 37 representing various banks and local head offices of State Bank of India.

Shri R N Dash GM, RBI, Hyderabad participated in the inaugural session. In his address, he said that RSETIs are playing vital role in skill development of unemployed youth and engaging them in self employment by way of micro enterprises. He said that credit is an important instrument for development of the people. He expressed his concern that only 30% of RSETI trainees are credit linked. He further said that to improve the credit linkages attitudinal changes are required at branch managers level. At the same time proper identification of trainees and quality of the training is also important.

Dr. M V Rao, IAS, DG, NIRD&PR interacted with the participants. Participants shared their experience with DG and brought to his notice specific issues of problems in land allotment and sought his intervention. Dr. Rao assured to take up the matter with respective Govts & Dist. administration. Dr. Rao also emphasized need for availability of credit to RSETI trainees, which is not coming forth, inspite of fact that RSETIs are bank led institutions. He appealed the participants to find wage and means to improve the credit linkages.

The faculty support for the workshop was provided by Shri O N Bansal, PD RSETI NIRD&PR, Shri K N Janardhana, CPC and Shri Vasudev Kalkundri, Sr Faculty, Monitoring Cell. Shri Bansal while welcoming the participants explained the purpose & objectives of the workshop, he reviewed & discussed various issues related with allotment/possession of the land and construction of RSETI's buildings. Shri Janardhana discussed issues related with pre-training, training and post-training, grading parameters, best practices followed by various RSETIs. Shri Kalkundri talked about role & responsibilities of Nodal Officers & need for reconciliation of manual data with MIS. The participants were also taken for a field visit to SBH RSETI Chilukur, to have a look at available infrastructure. To study types of programmes conducted and their impact in terms of settlement and to give suggestions for better functioning. The participants had a chance to interact with trainees of ongoing programmes as well as with successful entrepreneurs. The participants were also taken for a field visit to Rural Technology Park at NIRD&PR. The pre valedictory session was utilized as 'open house' to discuss various issues related with RSETIs & to clarify various doubts of the participants.

Editorial**Need to improve bank linkages**

Dear Readers,

All RSETIs are conducting need based capacity building and skill upgradation training programmes for rural youths. Giving training is one aspect and settlement of the trainees is another aspect. The training has no meaning if there are no settlements. On review of settlement it is observed that settlement rate of various RSETIs are in the range of 40% to 90% depending upon age and geographical location of the RSETI. It is heartening to note that the average settlement rate under RSETI Project is 64%. However majority of the candidates stand settled with self finance and lesser number of candidates with bank finance. Thus, the very purpose of making RSETIs, bank led institutions is not fulfilled. Hence, there is urgent need to improve the bank linkages of RSETI trainees.

By default 70% of RSETI trainees are from BPL category. While, on the other hand data reveals that 70% of the settlement with self finance. It is difficult to understand this phenomenon. How BPL candidates arrange self finance? Under these circumstances it is presumed that all such trainees may be availing finance from private money lenders at exorbitant rate of interest. If so, it is not a good sign and the very purpose of running the RSETIs by the Banks is defeated.

The reasons for poor bank linkages may be many but, the major reason seems to be indifferent attitude of the Branch Managers towards RSETI trainees. Thus, there is a need to sensitize them to extend helping hand to the RSETI Trainees. This can be done by involving BMs including RRBs in sponsoring the candidates and in the training process itself. A few suggestions in this direction are : i) Motivating the BMs to sponsor the candidates, ii) Inviting the BMs in inauguration/valediction and / or during the course of training for an interaction with the trainees iii) Forwarding project proposals to the Bank branches by Director RSETIs iv) Strong & periodical follow-up/ review of pending applications either individually or in BLBCs/ DCCs/ DRLCs, v) Rejection of the RSETI trainees loan application on flimsy ground should be brought to the knowledge of higher authorities/ Dist. Collector, vi) Rejection of the RSETI trainees loan applications only by controlling authorities as in case of SC/STs, vii) Assisting the trainees in completing the required formalities/ paper work required by branches etc. may give positive results.

Director/faculties may also assure the BMs that they will be in touch with the trainees and will also assist them in recovery of the loans if need arises. This will boost the confidence of the branch managers for sanctioning of the loans to RSETI trainees. **Let's make sincere efforts in this direction to ensure that at least 50% settlement should be through bank linkages. We are confident that with sincere efforts it is possible.**
