7th Annual Day of APBIRED, Hyderabad



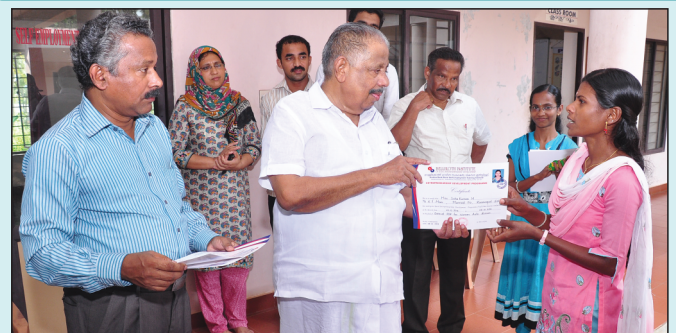
APBIRED, Hyderabad celebrated its 7th Annual day on 9.10.2014. The celebration was presided by Shri V B Bhagavathi, Member Secretary & GM, Andhra Bank. **Dr. M V Rao IAS, DG NIRDPR & CEO, National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB)** was the chief guest. 17 Ex. trainees who have settled after taking skill development training from the institute were invited on this occasion to share their success with the trainees of ongoing programmes. Celebrations started with invocation of Vandemataram & lighting the lamp by the dignitaries. In his welcome address, Shri Bhagavathi narrated the genesis and functioning of the institute. He appreciated the performance of the institute and advised to enhance the skill up gradation programmes. Director of the institute Shri M Krishna Rao presented report on performance of the institute since inception. Since inception (Oct. 2007) to September, 2014, institute has conducted 273 training programmes in which 6594 candidates were trained, of which 2886 are women. Out of total candidates trained, 2042 have established their units and settled as self-employed, and 2204 have gone for wage employment. The average settlement rate is 64%. The Director also informed future outlook of the institute i.e. to switch over to skill up-gradation programmes (advanced courses) for the candidates who undergone basic training at RSETIs and other similar institutions.



The candidates who have settled after the training at APBIRED shared their experience with the dignitaries and their fellow trainees. Two women who have undergone beautician training in Feb 2014 (one from Chittoor Dist. and other from East Godavari Dist.) said that they came to know of the institute through newspaper notification and convinced their family members to join training. They expressed that quality of the training and other arrangements at the institute are so good that they did not feel that they are away from their home. The training has instilled courage and enhanced their self-confidence. They started their own beauty parlours at their home town and now they are proudly contributing to their family income. Other settled candidates also expressed the same views and were happy that they could earn their bread and butter due to meticulous training imparted by APBIRED with utmost discipline at the campus.

The chief guest **Dr. M V Rao IAS** in his address admired the concept of the institute and said that more institutions are required with such a dedication and hard work. Globally our country is recognised as Young India because majority of our population is in the age group of 18-35. He said, our youth, if properly trained and given right guidance will become a great asset to the country; otherwise the same youth may be attracted to anti social activities. Dr. Rao advised the institute to continuously review the training programmes and modify them according to the contemporary needs. He complemented the management, director and team for their commitment towards youth and services to the society. Dr. M V Rao released the quarterly newsletter of the institute i.e. "SWAYAM UPADHI" and appreciated the efforts put in by the institute.

Editorial**Youth Empowerment through RSETIs***Dear Readers*

RSETIs are promoted by MoRD realizing the need for promoting self employment amongst unemployed rural youth particularly those below the poverty line and for their periodic skill up gradation to keep them abreast of latest technologies and management practices. While launching the programme it was proposed to have 600 RSETIs across the country i.e. one in each district. Today, we have 583 functional RSETIs across the country. These RSETIs are bank driven institutions duly supported by central & state govts. The RSETIs have contributed tremendously towards empowerment of the youth. India is the youngest country, approximately 65% population of the country is in the age group 18 to 35 years. The RSETIs are working for this target group. As on December, 2014, all the RSETIs put together have given skill development training to 1094201 candidates. It is heartening to note that majority of the candidates trained are women. Thus, RSETIs have immensely contributed towards Women Empowerment also. Out of total number of candidates trained i.e 1094201, 669269 candidates are settled and are contributing to their family incomes. Their average income is Rs.4,000/- to Rs.50,000/- per month. These settled (successful) trainees have also become job providers. Thus, equal number of youths is employed by them. Thus the real beneficiaries are more than doubled. Taking the average family size of 4, RSETIs have empowered a large number of individuals. This is quite significant. RSETIs will continue to play its role in the days to come in empowerment of the youth and making them self reliant.

*- Editor***Common conclaves for RSETI Directors**

Two common conclave of RSETI Directors were organized for the banks which have less than 10 RSETIs, one at Ghaziabad and the other at Bangalore. The conclave at Ghaziabad was held on 8-9th December 2014 at Hotel Krishna Sagar. Bank of Baroda
