RSETI Diwas Celebrations - 2017

National level RSETI Diwas 2017 was celebrated on 7th June 2017 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. On this occasion, **Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, Co-Chairman, NLAC of RSETIs** briefly explained the purpose of establishing Rural Development and Self-Employment Training Institutes (RUDSETIs) and their journey so far. He said that Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India appreciated the excellent work done by them and decided to replicate this model by establishing one such Institute with the help of involving the Lead Banks in each District through out the country in the name of 'Rural Self-Employment Training Institute' (RSETI). As on the day, there are **587 RSETIs** through out length and breath of the country. These RSETIs have trained more than 23 lakhs rural youth, out of which more than 13.50 lakhs are successfully engaged in self-employment activities, resulting in settlement rate of over 66%, besides creating wage employment opportunities to the tune of 1.66 lakhs. Dr. Heggade said that RSETIs are having multiplying effect, since many of these self-employed entrepreneurs provide job opportunities to many more unemployed youth.

Shri Narendra Singh Tomar, Hon'ble Union Minister, Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Drinking Water and Sanitation, who was the Chief Guest of the function, lauded the role played by Bankers in addressing the unemployment problem through RSETIs. He appreciated Dr. Heggade for visualising the

RSETI model and thanked him profusely for his concern for well-being of the unemployed youth. **Shri Ram Krupal Yadav, Hon'ble Minister of State for Rural Development and Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance** were also present on the occasion. They appreciated the role being played by RSETIs in imparting training to rural unemployed youth. They assured to provide required support to the RSETIs.

MD&CEOs and top other Executives of sponsor Banks of RSETIs, Secretary (RD), Joint Secretaries of Central Government, DG NIRD&PR, Principal Secretary (RD) and top level officials from State Governments and Directors of RSETIs participated in the function. Awards were given to Best Performers in the category of States, Banks and RSETIs for the financial year 2014-15 and 2015-16 on this occasion. Awards were also given to NDR NACER and DG NAR for their contribution to the RSETI movement. Five Successful Entrepreneurs who were trained by RSETIs shared their experiences and were honoured by the guests on this occasion. 'Annual Activities Report 2016-17' of NACER and 'Yashopath', a compendium of Success Stories of selected trainees from RSETIs and 'Assessment & Certification Protocol' were also released. More than 1200 delegates participated in the RSETI Diwas Celebrations. **"It was a day of celebration for all RSETIans"**.

Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)

Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) are unique skill development organizations operating in all districts across the country. They are engaged in developing skill among the unskilled/semi skilled youth and facilitate the trained persons to establish rural enterprises and secure sustainable livelihoods. Though RSETIs are sponsored and managed by different Banks they have a common objective of promoting creation of sustainable rural enterprises. The RSETIs need to have uniform practices, systems and procedures. RSETIs also required to have standardised training infrastructure and inputs to bring in quality outcome. Hence it is decided to have systematically documented Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for RSETIs to ensure consistency in their operations and facilitate the stakeholders to have standard source of reference.

Documenting the Standard Operating Procedures gains still higher significance in view of the stakeholder multi-diversity in the RSETI programme. RSETI is a three-way partnership between Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India, the Banks and the State Governments. It is essential to have a standard document of reference so that all the partners perform their respective roles with clarity. In the above backdrop, NAR has developed a set of 4 SOPs covering the entire gamut of RSETI functioning as under:

He assured that bank will complete the construction work in a time bound manner in all RSETIs.

Shri Bajaj, MD&CEO of the bank in his address conveyed thanks to the guests for their continuous support and guidance to RSETIs. He emphasized that RSETIs continues to be an area of priority for the bank. Alike other important functional areas. He expressed that there is much room for betterment in the functioning of RSETIs through increasing credit linkages for settlement. Shri Janardhana lauded the performance of Bank's, RSETIs in surpassing the overall AAP target for the year 2016-17 and achieving settlement rate of 62%. He impressed upon the bank to give special thrust on credit linkage, as this year credit linkage would be a major parameter in grading of RSETIs. Shri Kalkundri presented a power point on CNN.

Shri Bansal discussed construction of RSETI buildings vis-a-vis release of grant by MoRD. He informed that as per decision of MoRD, only 500 RSETIs will get infrastructure grant of Rs.1.00 crore on first cum first basis. He said that MoRD restricted the infrastructure grant to Rs.1.00 crore only and additional funds are to be provided by concern bank. He also informed RSETI building must have minimum 8000 sq fts covered area. He requested to speed up the construction work. Shri P K Pradhan, Principal, STC proposed vote of thanks.

Central Bank of India

However, he said that RSETIs to be vigilant to grading exercise for the FY 2016-17, there may be huge changes in the parameters. The settlement should be more than 70% with linkages to Bank Credit of more than 50%. Shri Kalkundri reviewed the performance of the RSETIs.

Shri O N Bansal, PD RSETI, NIRD&PR presented birds eye view on infrastructure of RSETIs. He appreciated the performance of bank in development of infrastructure. He pointed out how omission of minor things like provision of wash basin, separate area for washing utensils, partition between male & female dormitories create hindrances in smooth functioning of RSETI. Shri Gupta and Shri Phool Singh CM, while interacting with the participants, identified action points emerged out of conclave. The conclave ended with the vote of thanks by Shri Phool Singh CM & Nodal Officer RSETIs from central office.
