

SECTION - 9: PANCHAYATI RAJ

As a sequel to the 73rd Constitutional Amendment, the Panchayati Raj Institutions (3-tier structure) came into existence in almost all the States and UTs, though, with minor variations in structure and mode of election.

- 9.1 & 9.2: Data on number of grassroots level (Gram Panchayats), middle level (Panchayat Samities/Taluka Panchayats) and district level (Zilla Parishads) institutions existing in different States and All-India as on September 30, 2014 are presented.
- 9.3: Data on total number of lower level (Gram Panchayats), middle level (Panchayat Samities/ Taluka Panchayats) and higher level (Zilla Parishads) institutions and total elected representatives at all levels showing break-up into SC,ST,OBC and women in different States and UTs during 2007-08 are included.
- 9.4: State-wise Elected Representatives at Village Panchayats level showing break-up into SC, ST, OBC and women are furnished for 2007-08.
- 9.5: State-wise Elected Representatives at Intermediate Panchayats level with break-up of SC, ST, OBC and women members are included for 2007-08.
- 9.6: State-wise Elected Representatives at District Panchayats level with break-up of SC, ST, OBC and women members are shown in this Table for 2007-08.
- 9.7(a & b): The fund allocation by 13th Finance Commission during 2011-12, 2012-13 , 2013-14 and 2014-15 are shown.
- 9.8: Number of Elected Representatives and Functionaries trained during 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12 for States are presented.
- 9.9, 9.10 & 9.11: Allocation and Release of Backward Regions Grant Fund (BRGF) grants in 2013-14, 2014-15 and 12th Five Year Plan are shown, India and State-wise.
- 9.12: This Table provides data on notified Fifth Scheduled Areas.
- 9.13: Financial Progress under Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Sashatikaran Abhiyan as on 2013-14 to 2015-16.
- 9.14: Details of financial support under RGPSA for Panchayat in PESA area during the year from 2013-14 to 2016-17 is shown in this table.
- 9.15 & 9.16: Component-wise amount sanctioned under RGPSA to PESA states and only for PESA during 2015-16 and 2016-17 are given in these tables.
- 9.17: Release of Basic Grant to the State Government for Rural Local Bodies during 2015-16.

Highlights

- At present, the Panchayati Raj institutional network is very wide (in size) and broad based (in terms of social group-wise composition). About three million elected representatives are managing these local bodies and are involved in planning for economic development and social justice in rural areas of the country.
- Representation of Women, SC and ST in these local bodies is as per the stipulated norms. With an exception of States like Bihar, Karnataka and Odisha, the share of women is more than one-third (reservation) norm; which is a welcome sign.
