Admission Notification for Distance Mode Programme Diploma Programme on Panchayati Raj Governance and Rural Development (DP-PRGRD) Batch-3 (2021)

About the Programme: NIRDPR is commencing its 3rd Batch of 12-month Diploma Programme on Panchayati Raj Governance and Rural Development (DP-PRGRD) in Distance Mode from February, 2021. Special Features: Self-instructional material shall be provided in soft copy only, to the enrolled students and the same will be available in the Learning Management System portal on NIRDPR website. The materials include instructions for self-study and self-assessment exercises. Contact classes and semester-end examination centres are spread across the country.

Eligibility: A Graduate degree in any discipline from a UGC-recognised university. Reservation criteria will be followed as per the Government of India norms.

Duration: Twelve Months.

Medium of Instruction: English

Programme Fee: Rs.10,000/- (for Gen/OBC) & Rs. 9,000/- (for SC/ST/PH), to be deposited through online in two equal instalments at the commencement of first and second semesters.

Evaluation and Examinations: DP-PRGRD Course will be offered in two semesters and will have 30 marks for the continuous evaluation through assignments and 70 marks for semester-end examinations (Total 100 marks). The students will also have to undertake a Project relating to Panchayati Raj & Development in the second semester which will carry 100 marks.

Selection Criteria: Selection of candidates will be done by a selection committee duly constituted for the purpose.

How to apply: The online application accompanied by a payment for Rs. 500/- (for Gen/OBC) & Rs. 300/- (for SC/ST/PH candidates) towards application fee along with self attested copies of the required certificates as mentioned in the application form should be uploaded through online process at www.nirdpr.org.in.

The last date for filling the online application is 15th January, 2021.
