INSTRUCTIONS TO FILMMAKERS

- The theme of the film should be strictly confined to any of the above mentioned topics
- The films with themes other than the mentioned topics will be rejected
- The duration of film should be between 10 to 15 minutes
- The footage should be of good quality with a clear synchronizing audio
- If the medium of language is other than English or Hindi, there should be appropriate subtitles in English language
- The film should be not more than 3 years old
- The DVD of Film should be sent to Prof. & Head, CDC, NIRD&PR, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad - 5000 030 and it should reach Before **OCTOBER 20th, 2017**
- Relevant contact details of film makers should be given
- A self-declaration stating the certifying of content and footage should be submitted along with the film
- The Institute reserves the right to use the selected films for our training and research purposes
- Selected film makers should bring their film in DVD/Pen Drive to the screening venue
- The makers of selected films are requested to be present at screening or make themselves available on video call for interaction with audience post-screening
- The Institute will not provide travel allowances. However, accommodation will be provided for selected film makers on NIRD&PR campus during the Film Festival.
