Invitation for Reporting Best Model of RURBAN Clusters

Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (2015) is a flagship program of Ministry of Rural Development which aims at development of rural growth clusters based on the local potential. With a focus on providing/ strengthening economic activities in group of villages, Rurban clusters are being created with developing skills, local entrepreneurship and infrastructure amenities. The initial step is to create 300 Rurban clusters across the country within 5 years on convergence mode with 70% source of funding from different schemes under Govt. and private sectors and 30% funding from Govt. towards CGF (Critical Gap Funding). As on 2020-21, 292 clusters were formed which are progressing with different stages of implementation. Complete guidelines of the scheme are available on https://rurban.gov.in. In order to encourage post graduate students of NIRDPR to associate with economic development activities of villages, NIRDPR is conducting competitions on documentation of best models of Rurban clusters.

- ❖ Eligibility: All the successful students belonging to the batches up to PGDRDM (Batch-18) and of PGDM-RM (Batch-3)
- How to participate: Eligible persons who propose to undertake the proposed study on any of Rurban Cluster of choice with their own expenses can submit report in the prescribed format (enclosed). In the first step, the participants are required to go through the available literature and secondary data gathered through key informants and should focus on developing a better concept-to-completion model for implementation of Rurban in cluster mode while involving SHGs. Reports generated with relevant photographs and video-clippings depicting the actual work done by the competitors/ participants will be essential to claim meritorious work.
- Prize Money: Out of the total full-fledged reports received from the competitors, the best first two reports will be awarded with cash prize along with certificate of appreciation.

First Prize - Rs. 10,000 Second Prize - Rs. 8,000

- Mode of Selection: Selection will be done by a team evaluators approved by the competent authority. Evaluation of the reports will be done based on the actual work done. The decision of evaluation team will be final. Except intimation to the successful persons by email and mobile, no further correspondence will be entertained.
