Introduction

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is a mission mode programme that aims at providing Functional House Tap Connection (FHTC) to every rural household by 2024. JJM is successfully creating the technical infrastructure required for providing water supply in rural areas. A significant pre-requisite for a functional water supply system is 'source sustainability and Operation and Maintenance' of the facilities created. There is a close connection between shelf-of-works prepared under MGNREGS and the success of sources identified for JJM. Similarly, there is a dire need for preparing the Gram Panchayats to systematically plan and take up Operation and Maintenance so that the vision of FHTC is realised - irrespective of season.

Objectives of the Programme

1. Describe and explain to the faculty members of SIRDs and other trainers on the potential role RD&PR can play in enabling every household get FHTC;
2. Identify the type of works required to be incorporated in the shelf of work of MGNREGS and the type of advisories that can help at district / block levels in order to ensure source sustainability, regularity of drinking water supply, and by setting up grey water recycle systems;
3. Calculate and demonstrate the need for water budgeting, water audit, and how MGNREGS can contribute to the Government of India's vision of creating water sufficient villages.
4. Analyse and put across the elements involved in successful Operation & Maintenance of the WASH facilities created at Gram Panchayat level.

Participants

This programme primarily aims at covering the Faculty members of SIRDs, RIRDs, DIRDs and ETCs involved in conducting training programmes on MGNREGS. KRCs working for JJM, who focus on source sustainability and Operation and Maintenance are also encouraged to apply. This training programme will build the capacity of faculty members / trainers, who would be involved in roll out of JJM and MGNREGS programmes at states, with the support of State RWS / PHED / RD&PR.

Training Methods

The content of the programme - besides covering JJM related topics - aims at covering the entire flagship programmes of the Government of India viz. MGNREGS, WDC-PMKSY2.0, and SAKSHAM for source sustainability of drinking water. Therefore, sharing of good practices and discussion upon such practices will find prime place. This will help as enabler in cross-learning. There will be PowerPoint Presentations, Video shows, field visit and experience sharing sessions, and case presentations.

Expected outcome

Capacitated the faculty members of SIRDs / and other trainers who are instrumental in deciding the contents of training programmes of JJM and MGNREGS; influenced their thinking to be able to relate the plans of MGNREGS to source sustainability measures of JJM; and imparted the elements of Operation and Maintenance of rural water supply systems.
