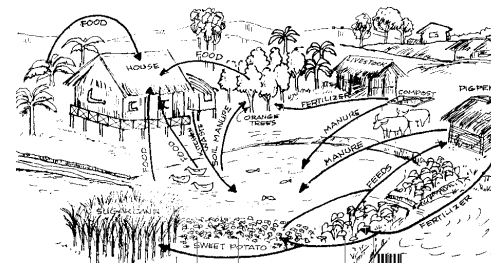

NEED

Planning for local economic development under MGNREGS has been mandated for the preparation of Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) to assess and use resources for economic development and social justice. The GPDP planning process has to be comprehensive and based on participatory process which involves the full convergence with schemes of all related Central Ministries / Line Departments related to 29 subjects enlisted in eleventh Schedules of the Constitution a part from MGNREGS. The GPDP, Labour budget and District irrigation Plan envisages "Ownership" among villagers wherein the enabling environment exists for local governmental institutions and community organizations to establish a collaborative partnership in undertaking the responsibility for developing a local "vision" and strategy, and for designing / planning, allocating resources, implementing and monitoring / evaluating of development activities that better cater to the local needs and establishment of Sustainable Rural Livelihoods. Considering the above ownership and enabling conditions of the local governments and community, there is a need to enhance the capacities of functionaries at various levels. Accordingly, the curriculum has been conceived and designed.

Programme Objectives

- To understand the enabling conditions of the resources (uses) and groups / people (users) in the Cluster Approach
- To enable the participants (knowledge & skill) on plan for GPs/Cluster using available resources/resource augmentation under MGNREGS
- To make familiarise different technologies and practices and use of human, financial and other related resources.
- To identify the community-centric, pro-active strategies for promotion of sustainable livelihoods.
