Two days Interactive Workshop under Project Enterprise (11th – 12th September 2013)

Poverty and Unemployment are the major problems of the rural areas and it is more so in tribal dominated and LWE districts. There is lack of opportunities for wage employment in these areas. NIRD realized that through skill development and capacity building, rural youth can be prepared to take up self employment ventures. Further, self employed persons act as a job creator. Hence, this is a long term solution to rural unemployment and poverty. In this backdrop NIRD took an initiative for skill development and capacity building of the youth in these areas under "Project Enterprise". The project is being implemented in association with a few reputed and well established Programme Implementing Agencies (PIAs), who are working in collaboration with one or other ministries and NABARD, with a sole objective of creation of micro enterprises' by the youth for his/her sustainable livelihood.



NIRD has supported 50 skill development & capacity building programmes covering approximately 1500 youths in various activities across the country till date. Average settlement rate is 70% – 75% in terms of creation of micro enterprises by the youth. In this backdrop, NIRD conducted two days interactive workshop on 11th - 12th September, 2013. The workshop was attended by 35 successful entrepreneurs from various parts of the country along with 15 representatives of PIAs.

Editorial**Grading of RSETIs**

A unique initiative was taken by MoRD in early 2009 under the banner of RSETI Scheme. The scheme envisages frame work for imparting free & residential quality training in skill development and capacity building. Post training follow up and credit linkages for establishing the micro enterprise is built in the scheme.

RSETIs are Bank Led Institutions. Today there are 576 functional RSETIs in the country, almost one in each district, which were established over a period of time. All these RSETIs put together have trained more than six lakhs youth. With growing number of RSETIs and number of youth trained, a need was felt to do the grading of these RSETIs. The objective of the grading is to create competitive spirit amongst the RSETIs as well as to ensure proper infrastructure and quality training. Accordingly MoRD with the help of Monitoring cell of NAR did first grading in the year 2011-2012 based on various parameters. A total of 504 RSETIs were graded, in the year 2011-2012, 38 RSETIs got A+, 79 got A, 147 got B, 107 got C and 133 got D. The Directors and Top Management of the sponsoring banks of those RSETIs which secured A+ & A were invited to a glittering RSETI day function organized at Vighyan Bhawan, New Delhi and were recognized by Hon'ble Minister of Rural Development.

For the year 2012-13, based on feedback, some modifications were made in grading process. All the functional RSETIs were categorized in three groups i.e. i) RSETIs which are in operation for more than 3 years, ii) RSETIs which are in operation 1 to 3 years and iii) RSETIs which are in operation for less than 1 year. RSETIs in first two categories were graded on different parameters as on 31.03.2013. In category (i) 310 RSETIs were graded. Out of this 147 got AA, 40 got AB, 30 got BA, 35 got BB, 06 got AC, 00 got AD, 04 got BC, 05 got BD, 12 got CA, 16 got CB, 07 got CC, 01 got CD, 00 got DA, 01 got DB, 04 got DC and 02 got DD. In category (ii) 214 RSETIs were graded. Out of this 86 got A, 77 got B, 33 got C and 18 got D.

Editorial team of Enterprise CONGRATULATES all the Banks and their RSETI Directors who secured AA, AB, BA & BB in category (i) and A & B in category (ii). The other RSETIs not to worry, as there is scope to, improve the grading in 2013-2014 with little efforts. The RSETIs who got A, B and combination of A & B have to worry to maintain their grading in 2013-2014.

The objectives of workshop were; a) to share the experience among the successful entrepreneurs, b) to document success stories of the entrepreneurs and c) to discuss & workout strategies for up-scaling the project activities.

The workshop started with prayer to build the self confidence among entrepreneurs and was inaugurated by **Dr M V Rao, IAS, DG NIRD**. He interacted with the entrepreneurs, gave a patient hearing and cross examined them to know impact of training programmes, live situation regarding their micro enterprise and average monthly income earned by them. Each representative of the PIA made a brief presentation on their activities, selection of youth, conduct of training, follow-up and hand holding services provided by them to the trainees.

On this occasion a small exhibition was also organized displaying the products made by the entrepreneurs, tools equipments used by them as well as the tool kits provided to them by the PIAs. At the end of the workshop DG NIRD presented mementos to each participant. Dr S M Ilyas, PD DEC, Dr P Shivram, PD RTP, Sri K P Rao, P&H CSERE, Dr C S Singhal, P&H CWDGS were also associated with the workshop. The workshop was coordinated by Sri O N Bansal, PD RSETI and Sri R Naga Lakshmaiah, PM RSETI.

4th NLSC meeting at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi

The 4th National Level Steering Committee (NLSC) was held at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi on 20th August, 2013 under the Chairmanship of **Sri Vijayanand, IAS, Additional Secretary, MoRD**. **Sri T Vijay Kumar, IAS, J S MoRD**, Smt. Renuka, DS, GMs of all the major banks, representatives of RBI, NABARD, SIDBI, NIRD, NIESBUD, NAR and selective SRLMs were also present. In the opening remarks Sri Vijayanand congratulated the banks for the improvement in performance of their RSETIs. He advised the banks to focus on quality and move ahead on basis of evidence based results. He said that coordination at central level is excellent, however at state & district level it is weak. He also expresses his concerned about the slow progress on infrastructure front. Sri T Vijay Kumar made a presentation on each of the agenda item then ask the banks to list out the steps taken for improving the performance of the RSETIs. The GM of each and every bank presented their view points. The major action points emerged during the meeting are i) Capacity building of the Bank to undertake mentoring / monitoring work of their RSETIs, ii) Establishment of RSETIs in North Eastern Region, iii) Sensitization of RSETI Directors, LDMs, DDM NABARD, PD DRDAs in N E States. iv) Registration of RSETIs as VTP and NCVT Certification, v) Land related issues to be taken up with the states during PRC, vi) Establishment of help line for RSETI trainees, vii) Issue of unique code to track flow of credit to RSETI trainees, viii) Study of micro enterprise consultants model of Kudmbashree by GM (PS) of the Banks and ix) Bringing out a publication detailing good practices followed by various Banks.

Conclave of RSETIs Directors

Central Bank of India

Central bank of India organized two Days Conclave of RSETIs Directors at Sir Sorabji Pochkhanawalla Banker's Training College, Mumbai on 12th & 13th July, 2013. The conclave was addressed by **Sri M V Tanksale, CMD, Central Bank of India**, Sri A P Dwivedi, CEO Society / Trust for RSETI & FLCC of CBI, Sri R B Gupta, GM (PS), and Dr R Bhaskaran, CEO, IIBF, Mumbai.



The main area of concern in the conclave was improvement in Grading of RSETIs and to review the performance of individual RSETI. Sri O N Bansal, PD RSETI, NIRD reviewed and discussed issues related with allotment / possession of the land and construction of RSETI buildings while Sri K N Janardhana, CPC Monitoring Cell, reviewed individual performance of the RSETIs and gave observations for his improvement. During the review, gaps hampering the efficient functioning of RSETIs were identified and suggestions/remedial measures were given. Sri Bimbh, in his valedictory address emphasized that skill development programmes should have greater orientation on self employment. Training should be supplemented by timely credit linkages for sustainable vocation.
