As a sequel to the 73rd Constitutional Amendment, the Panchayati Raj Institutions (3-tier structure) came into existence in almost all the States and UTs, though, with minor variations in structure and mode of election.

Highlights

- The Panchayati Raj institutional network in the country is very wide (in size) and broad based (in terms of social group-wise composition) . As of 04-12-2020, there exist 659 district panchayats, 6829 block/mandal panchayats and 2,55,536 gram panchayats in the country. About three million elected representatives at various levels are managing these local bodies and are involved in planning for economic development and social justice in rural areas of the country.
- Representation of Women, SC and ST in the local bodies is as per the stipulated constitutional norms. In almost all major states, the one-third reservation norm for women has been complied with which is a welcome sign.

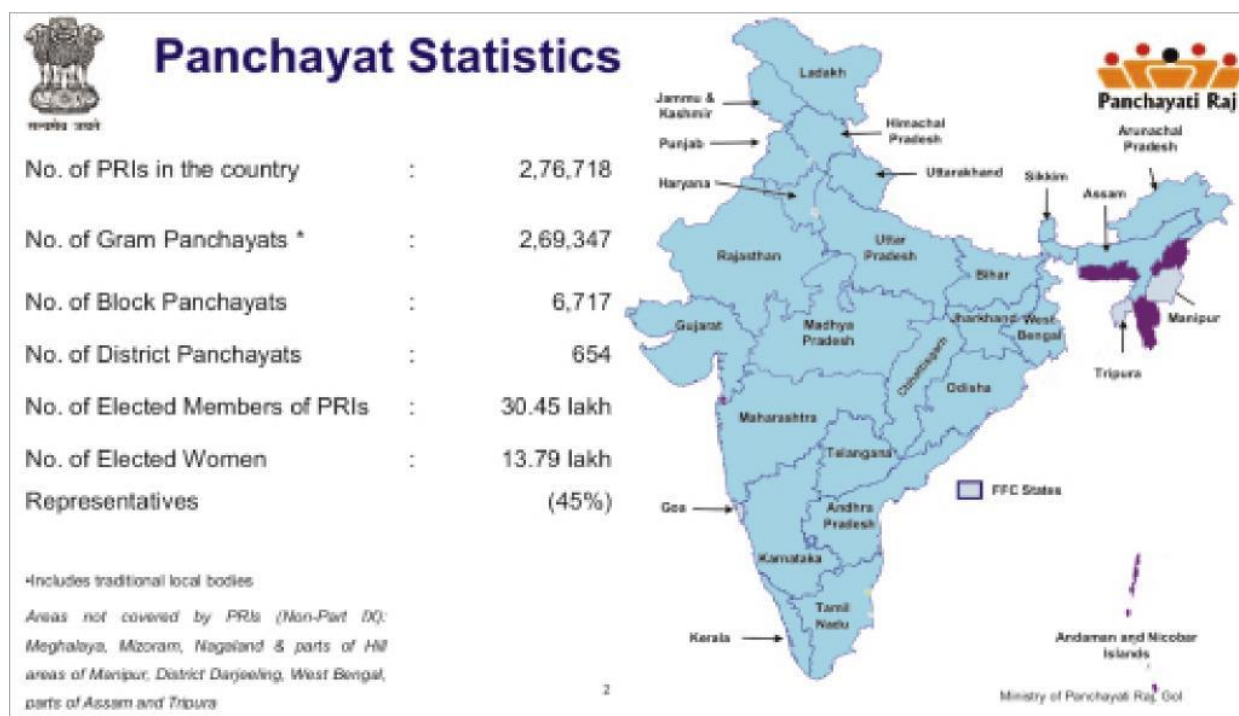
